He has been a whistleblower and exposed several cases of corruption. On his complaint, CBI registered cases of Corruption in DVC, which led to recovery of crores of rupee illegally paid to vendors. He is a Petitioner in three Writ including one PIL cases in High Courts of Calcutta, Ranchi & Bombay against mismanagement, corruption in Government Sponsored insurance schemes (IRDA, ICICI Lombard & others). He has filed more than thousand RTI applications with Government of India & Public Sector Undertakings and exposed corruption and mismanagement. He was also nominated for Transparency International's Integrity Award in 2010.</p>
